We are located in north Kohrman Hall. When we leave at night alone (from 9 pm to after midnight--even later for students), the parking area behind middle Kohrman where the service vehicles park is extremely dark and unsafe. No one would hear anyone in trouble. Likewise, on most nights the lights in the Trimpe parking lot are out and it is very, very dark. On two recent occasions I have been walking up the driveway (since there is no walkway anymore) from Kohrman Hall to the Trimpe parking lot and drivers of cars have not seen me to the last minute. The northwest door of Kohrman Hall has bushes around it and only one light partially works (the outside light to the left of the door hasn't worked in a very long time). I am scared at times and very concerned about the welfare of students who are working late and walking to and from the building alone. Once these student housing units go up in the huge parking lot across from Trimpe where will students, staff and faculty park? They will have to walk even further at night, alone, in the dark to go to their cars. I am worried about everyone's safety.</p>
