Evie: Listed below is the input received from our grounds staff. These deal directly with maintenance issues. Not a hole lot of "must keeps".....but several "must haves" !!

1. Bench/seating area out of snow removal's way.
2. Heated walks!!!!!! (fat chance!!).
3. NO bricks in walks or planters.
4. NO annual/perennial beds.....the use of planters only for seasonal color.
5. Good tree selection.....NO Honey locust! and planting should be "off" the walks.
6. Irrigation efficiency, especially for trees and annual flower planters. (easy water access)
7. Plaza is a maze, many obstacles, too busy, need better traffic flow not only for pedestrians, but for snow removal also.
8. NO recycling clusters.
9. Directional sign age and/or possible orientation kiosks.
10. More green space. Remove barriers from lawn area providing ped. traffic flow does not create path.
11. Better lighting and placement.
